Community Partners Choices for Independence

What is the *Choices* for *Independence* program?

Choices for Independence (CFI) is a home and community-based program funded by NH Medicaid, providing a wide range of services designed to help eligible individuals remain in their home and community.

Who qualifies for CFI?

Individuals 18 and older who have met financial and medical criteria are deemed eligible by the NH Department of Health and Human Services. Once eligible, you will be assigned a Case Management Agency, or you may request one from the State if you prefer.

The mission of Community Partners is to connect our clients and their families to the opportunities and possibilities for full participation in their communities.

We provide Person-Centered Case Management Services

Your CFI case manager will complete an assessment to determine the services that you need to live independently. This includes consulting with your family members and our providers to determine what supports are already in place and where there may be gaps to fill.

Case Managers will meet regularly with you and advocate for services critical to your care to support you in your desire to remain living at home .
