Both Boards of Directors voted and signed a Letter of Intent for Community Partners to acquire SENHS.

Due Diligence process started for Community Partners to gather information on SENHS' fiscal operations.

Letter of Intent

Both boards voted and signed an Agreement, detailing conditions under which Community Partners will acquire SENHS.

An application is sent to the NH Attorney General's office.

SENHS will continue operations as usual until a closing date, targeted for June 30, 2025.

Both groups learn more about each other. Begin HR processes.

Agreement

SENHS employees become Community Partners employees.

Two SENHS Board members join the Community Partners Board.

All SENHS programs continue as is for at least one year.

Opportunities for dual programming are explored.

Administrative processes are integrated.
